ORDER

The challenge in the present application is two Notices/ Letters dated 17 February 2025 as well as 18 February 2025 issued by the Respondent No.1 i.e. Mumbai Port Authority and Respondent No.2 i.e. Royal Bombay Yacht Club respectively by which charges for use of Jetty No.5 at Gateway of India are demanded.

Today, Learned Advocate appearing on behalf of Respondent No.1 has supplied a copy of Writ Petition (L) No.38528 of 2025 filed in the High Court of Judicature at Bombay (Original Ordinary Civil Jurisdiction) and has submitted that the Applicant has challenged a Notification No.FA/ACC/232/2036 issued by the Respondent No.1 i.e. Mumbai Port Authority dated 27 October 2025 by which the tariff for use of Jetty No.5 have been decided on the line of two Notices/ Letters dated 17 February 2025 and 18 January 2025.



It was further submitted that in view of challenge of Notification before the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, the present Application would not survive. It was, therefore, argued that the Application may be dismissed.

On the other hand, the Learned Advocate for the Applicant requests for time to take appropriate instructions.

The matter be listed for hearing on 13 March 2026.
